The CHSA 200 Club is an easy way to contribute to CHSA funds and you could win up to £200.

The CHSA 200 Club is a form of lottery to generate income for the CHSA.

A subscription to the **CHSA 200 Club costs £20 per annum.**



Around 35% of the proceeds of the club are distributed in prizes with the rest being added to CHSA funds.

Each £20 subscription gives you one entry in the draw. The more people who join the club the bigger the prizes will be.

The draw usually takes place at a school production in the summer term. The first prize is £200 with a number of smaller prizes depending on the number of subscriptions purchased at the time of the event.



Payments must be received by the beginning of June for subscribers to be included in the draw so make sure you submit your application in time so you can take part this year.

Anyone can buy a subscription to the **CHSA 200 Club** - not just the parents of Christleton High School students - so do pass on information to friends and family.

# Christleton High School Association

CHSA (Christleton High School Association) is run by a small committee made up of parent/ carer volunteers and school staff. It also has a valuable team of regular volunteers, who help out at school events.

The aim of CHSA is to raise much needed funds to enhance your children's experience at CHS. The money raised over the school year is redistributed to school departments, who submit bids for additional items to enrich your child's learning experience.

This funding will become even more critical over the coming years with recently announced government cuts to school budgets.



In recent years the CHSA has funded resources for the iResearch Centre, an archaeology project, a 3D printer and activities during Futures Week.

Recently, we have agreed to support purchase of some new computers, cameras for use in the art department, STEM Club Robot Kits and to fund a new initiative for science teaching.



For 2017 the CHSA was asked to help fund some new Bike Sheds.

Provision of these would mean a reduction in the number of car journeys to school and help students to get fitter and healthier at the same time!

But, we have limited opportunities to raise these much needed funds. You will have noticed refreshments being provided by the CHSA Committee and volunteers at events, such as Parents' Evenings and musical productions.
