Home Learning Guidelines

At Key Stage 3, the expectation is that students are given the following pieces of home learning. This is in line with the school's home learning policy for each year. The change reflects the move from 'homework' to 'home learning' and the increase of project-based tasks being set. Depending on the length of the home learning task students should have a proportional amount of time to complete it. **Students should have a minimum of two days, (normally at least three) to complete a home learning task.**
